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## Marriott-branded hotel to break ground in Midtown Miami



An AC Marriott Hotel will break ground in Midtown Miami after the developer secured a \$21.3 million construction loan.

Weston-based Florida Community Bank (NYSE: FCB) awarded the mortgage to Midtown Lodging 2 LLC, managed by Boaz Ashbel of Miami-based Aztec Group and Nikhil Desai of Tennessee-based 3H Hospitality. The developer acquired the 18,723-square-foot site at 3400 Biscayne Blvd. for \$1.25 million in January and demolished a 34-room hotel there.

The AC Marriott Hotel was approved for 153 rooms and will include a fitness center, a restaurant, a bar/lounge, meeting space, and a pool. It was designed by Kobi Karp.







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Aztec Group said the hotel should be completed in mid 2019. Ashbel arranged the deal.

"We are currently at a point where landing a hotel construction loan, even in strong hospitality markets like Miami, poses a challenge," Ashbel said. "Despite that, this product offering – with its strong brand affiliation and highly-visible location, defies the odds. With a financially strong and experienced borrower, there was little doubt of securing favorable financing terms. The AC Marriott Hotel will represent a welcomed addition to the Midtown market."

The new hotel will be situated between the Shops of Midtown and the Design District. It's also near the Julia Tuttle Causeway leading to Miami Beach. Over 21,000 vehicles pass the spot on Biscayne Boulevard every day.
